This Cookie Policy describes how Stunlock Studios AB, 556808-8198 ("**Stunlock**" or "**we**" in any form) uses cookies on our website. Stunlock uses cookies on stunlock.com to be able to provide necessary functions and improve the user experience of the website.

1. About cookies

A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and is stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server. Cookies may store user preferences and other information to enhance your experience on our website.

Cookies do not typically contain any information that personally identifies a user, but personal data that we store about you may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies. Please also see our [Privacy Policy](#) with regard to how we process personal data.

2. What types of cookies we use

Cookies may be either "persistent" cookies or "session" cookies: a persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date, unless deleted by the user before the expiry date; a session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed.

The purposes of cookies also include:

- **Strictly necessary cookies:** These cookies are necessary for you to be able to navigate within our website and to utilize its basic features.
- **Analytics and statistics cookies:** These cookies provides us with analytical information and statistics for the use of our websites and the services we provide.
- **Preference cookies:** These cookies provide you with certain functions – for example to remember your settings such as language preferences.

- Third-party cookies: These cookies are provided by third-parties. Please note that this Cookie Policy does not cover, and that we are not responsible for third-party cookies. We recommend that you consult the privacy and cookie policy of such third-party cookie provider.
